

To hold instructor credentials for this program a person must hold current professional registration with the Alberta College of Paramedics and complete an Instructor Development Course (IDC).

This training is exclusively available to members of the High School First Responder Team program and is not offered to the public. The training is focused on pre-hospital medical first response and follows the medical control protocols as established by the medical directors group within Alberta Health Services. The training exceeds the requirements for a workplace first aid course and as such is not registered with Worksafe Alberta.


